

Visiting Hours In General Wards

Starting on October 15, 2024, our hospital's visiting rules are as follows:

We will continue to monitor the social situation and make it easier for people to visit.

Visiting hours: Weekdays, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays between 1 p.m. and 8 p.m.

Frequency: No limit within the above time frames, approx. 60 min. per visit

Place: Either by the bedside with the curtains closed or in the waiting room behind the elevators

Number of people allowed: up to 3 people at a time

Who can visit: The key person will choose based on the patient's wishes. People who are healthy, over 10 years old, and can comply with the following:

(Precautions)

- Visitors shouldn't have a fever, cough, diarrhea, or feel unwell on the day of the visit.
- They and those around them shouldn't have been sick for the past week.
- Their child's school class shouldn't have been closed due to an infectious disease outbreak.
- Eating and drinking are prohibited during the visit. Face masks must be worn both by patients and visitors.

How to visit: Use the hand sanitizer at the ward's entrance, fill in the visitor form, and submit it at the nurse station.
